RV CAMPING

Rules and Regulations

The rules and regulations outlined below are intended to keep the RV camping area safe and orderly and to ensure a pleasant experience for everyone. RV camping spaces must be purchased with a four-day pass. If you have questions about your order or the sales process, please contact us at 800-343-7857.

YOU MUST GO TO FESTIVAL CHECK-IN BEFORE ENTERING THE RV LOT

CHECK-IN PROCESS

- After your order is complete, festival and RV tickets will be mailed to you. (Note: Parking stickers will not be mailed).
- These tickets will be exchanged at Festival Check-In for your parking stickers and festival access wristbands. You must have your wristband to enter the RV Campground.
- *As a reminder, your RV camping purchase includes a space and parking for one RV and one vehicle.*
- All entry and exit for the RV campground will be via NC Highway 268, Meadowview Drive to Stevens Lane.
- RVs will be parked based on order of arrival.
- No spaces may be held. If you plan to camp beside another group, you should arrive together.
- Site selection is not guaranteed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The RV campground is for self-contained RVs with hard-shell exteriors only (pop-ups allowed).
- Tents are prohibited.
- Campers must be able to fit the RV as well as any additional features in the space previously reserved.
- All vehicles must observe the campus speed limit.
- Coolers, backpacks and wristbands will be checked at the campground for festival entry.

SITE

- There are no electrical, sewer or water hookups.
- A dump station is located on Stevens Lane.
- Porta-johns are available within the campground.
- Please dispose of all trash in properly labeled containers.

HOURS OF OPERATION

- The RV campground will open at 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, April 24th. If you arrive prior to 2:00 P.M., you will be asked to leave campus until the RV campground opens.
- The RV campground will close at noon on Monday following the festival.

- The Wilkes Community College campus operates on a normal schedule during this time. Please be respectful of our students.

RV CAMPGROUND RULES

- NO firearms.
- NO fireworks.
- NO BBQ grills or open fires permitted on festival grounds.
- Talking, singing, radios, televisions, etc. must be kept at a volume that will not disturb other guests. “Quiet Time” will be from midnight to 7:00 A.M. Generators should be turned off to observe “Quiet Time”.
- Generators are permitted (note “Quiet Time rule above). Gas and fuel must be in approved containers and kept inside. Generator exhaust must not be bothersome to other guests.
- All RV campers must have a fire extinguisher easily visible from the outside or readily available from the door of the RV.
- Children should be supervised at all times.
- The RV campground host has the authority to enforce these rules throughout the event. By purchasing your tickets you agree to abide by RV Campground Rules as well as Festival Rules.

FESTIVAL POLICY

MerleFest is held rain or shine – We recommend bringing clothes for all seasons.

For your safety and the consideration of all guests and our campus, **the following are restricted from MerleFest:**

- All tobacco products (including chewing tobacco)
- Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs
- Pets
- Unauthorized ATVs, golf carts, Segway’s and bicycles (on campus and campgrounds)
Note: Bike racks are available at the festival entrance for storing bicycles.
- Unauthorized video or audio recording
- Glass containers
- Tents or canopies in concert areas

No one is permitted backstage without proper credentials (wristband).
